Reports:

Planning Board – (Minutes Submitted)

David Leavitt submitted a proposal from the Planning Board to adjust the fee schedule (attached). He explained that the proposed fee schedule is an attempt to put language into the schedule that makes the applicant pay for lawyers, etc., if necessary (for commercial applications and subdivision). Brian asked if the Planning Board was looking for a move on this proposal tonight. David said there is no circumstance now where this would be needed. - Jacob Miller – Map 9, Lot 13. Mobile Home was removed. Motion made and seconded to approve—all in favor.
- Julie and William Brown – Map 3, Lot 33 – Less acreage than assessed. Mike made a motion to approve abatement application – JoAnne seconded—all in favor.
- Julie and William Brown – Map 3, Lot 49 – Acreage wrong (45 acres, not 70). Motion made by Mike to approve for \$7,000-Vondell seconded—all in favor.
- Mike and Jody Tozier, 125 Gray Road. Abatement application for \$78,300. Mike suggested that they send the assessor to look at the property. Motion made by Mike to not accept the applications. Seconded by Vondell—all in favor.
- Supplemental for property taken out of Farm use (Greene Family Trust on the St. Albans Road—map 10 lot 5-A). \$613.19 more in taxes. Motion made by Mike to sign the supplemental—seconded by Vondell. All in favor.
