To Diane White, resident of Palmyra in said county,

Greetings:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of Palmyra, qualified to vote in town affairs, to assemble at the Palmyra Community Center in Palmyra on Wednesday, December 17, 2025 at 6:00 p.m., then and there to act on the following, to wit:

Art. 1 To elect a moderator by secret ballot to preside at said meeting.

Art. 2 To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Select Board, on behalf of the Town, to finance \$172,500 with an estimated 5.19% interest rate, to Lease Purchase a truck for the Public Works Department, and appropriate \$48,076.48 from surplus for the first payment.


At an estimated maximum interest rate of 5.19%, the estimated costs of this Master Lease Purchase Agreement will be:


