

**TOWN WARRANT
SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
TOWN OF PALMYRA**

To Diane White, resident of Palmyra in said county,

Greetings:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of Palmyra, qualified to vote in town affairs, to assemble at the Palmyra Community Center in Palmyra on Wednesday, July 16, 2025 at 7:00 p.m., then and there to act on the following, to wit:

Art. 1 To elect a moderator by secret ballot to preside at said meeting.

Art. 2 Shall the Town vote to authorize the Select Board to sell a portion of the land (approximately .8 acre) that was donated and accepted at the 2025 annual Town Meeting and appropriate proceeds to associated costs.

Art. 3 Shall the Town vote to raise and appropriate \$2100 for the survey and legal work needed to acquire donated land.

Art. 4 Shall the Town vote to amend the Subdivision Ordinance as follows
Subdivision Article 7. Performance Standards

Section 6. Wastewater Disposal:

a. The applicant shall submit evidence of site suitability for a subsurface wastewater disposal system in compliance with the Subsurface Wastewater Disposal Rules of the State of Maine, prepared by a State licensed site evaluator. ~~Common or shared subsurface wastewater disposal systems shall not be allowed, except within mobile home parks.~~ All test pit locations shall be shown on the subdivision plan and be accompanied by a HHE200 Form.

Art. 5 Shall the Town vote to appropriate funds from the Sale of Trailer purchased by the Community Center Boosters to the Palmyra Park Boosters Club.
